












## ABOUT NORDIC DECARBONIZATION FORUM JAPAN

- Make sure you create a thorough company profile on the platform in order to maximize the matchmaking opportunity. Slides, animations, and videos are often very useful.






## WHY JAPAN? 1: CARBON NEUTRALITY BY 2050

Japan has a target to achieve **carbon neutrality by 2050**, and the government is taking initiatives to cultivate sustainability and green innovation across industries.

The GX (Green Transformation)
Promotion Act stipulates that 150 trillion
yen in investments from public and private
sectors will be required over the next
decade to decarbonize society, with the
government contributing 20 trillion yen.






## WHY JAPAN? 2: GREEN TRANSITION AS ECONOMIC GROWTH

Shifting towards green and sustainability is recognized not only as a social responsibility but as a significant trigger for economic recovery, and the energy transition as an opportunity to improve the energy self-sufficiency rate. Currently Japan is depending over 85% of their energy resource on import.

The Green Innovation Fund, established in 2021 by the Minister of Economy, Trade, and Industry (METI) allocates 2.3 trillion yen to support companies working within the following 14 significant areas of potential economic growth.


